ADOPT A CHILD PROJECT

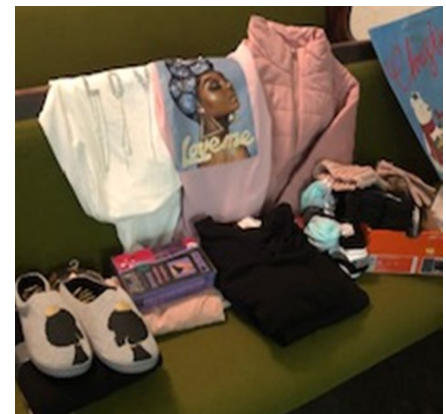
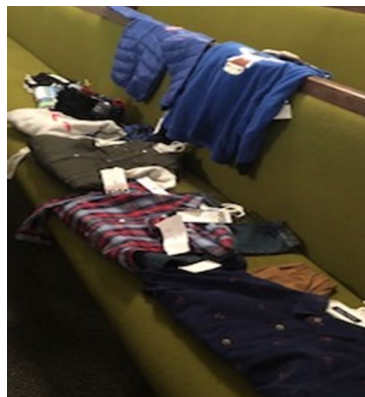
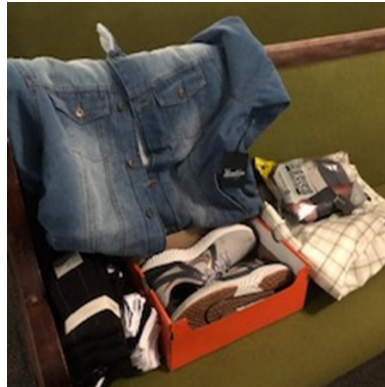
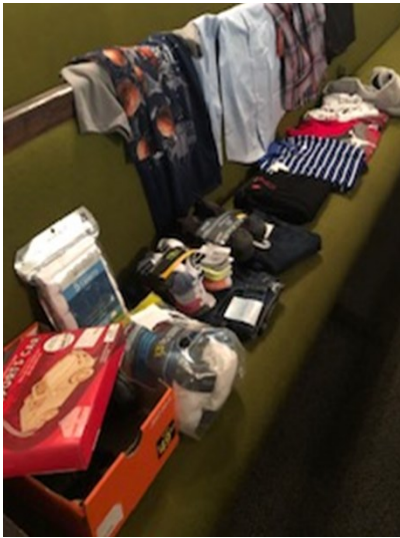
In 2020, Storehouse Hygiene Project Hosted the 3rd annual Adopt a child project. The project adopted five children, two girls ages 12 years old and 14 years old, three boys ages 23 years old, 10 years old and 4 year old. The project provides clothing, shoes, socks, under garments, coats, and personal items for each child in the family.

The program is a partnership with the educational system via teachers, counselors, and principals to determine a homeless or less fortunate family of children within their school.

This year each child received the following items: pajama set with bedroom slippers, one pair Nike shoes, packages of under garments, blouses or shirts, jeans, socks, coat, and belt. In addition, three family games were given: Jumanii, Jenga, and Uno Cards. The family received adult masks, children masks and hygiene Packages. The gifts for each child were placed in large Christmas bag and given on Christmas Eve.

A special thanks to the school officials and each storehouse member who serve to make this project successful!
